WEDNESDAY, JUNE 30

Classes IV and V RORC and SHR 6 and 7 assemble.

## RACING RULES

Note: All times at sea = Swedish time.

### FOR START

the international racing rules apply, with the exceptions mentioned.

Note: The regulations about warning shot - preparatory shot, see item 4 "Signals" p. 16.

Five minutes before a race begins, a starting pennant will be hoisted and a preparatory shot fired. The race will begin five minutes later when the pennant is hauled down and a second shot fired. In the event of the gun misfiring the hauling down of the starting pennant will signal the start of the race.

A start postponement, which will cover an interval of fifteen minutes, will be signalled from Sandhamns Stångskär by the "Answer pennant" of the international code (red and white pennant, vertical colours). If the start is to be postponed for more than one period of 15 minutes, the signal will be hauled down and rehoisted. A gun will be fired each time the "Answer pennant" is hoisted.

### RECALL

Recall number will not be shown. If any part of hull, crew or outfit has crossed the starting line or its extension, when the starting shot is fired, another shot shall be fired soonest possible and the number pennant 0 (yellow and red) be hoisted. A yacht that is prematurely on the starting line shall return and cross the line or its extension in accordance with Racing Rule No. 8. If the yacht does not do this, the Racing Committee shall decide on penalty. The Racing Committee does not inform a recalled yacht that it has completely returned to the right side of the starting line.

### FOR THE RACE

the rules issued in 1965 by the Scandinavian Yacht Club Association for open sea racing apply, with the following additions and modifications:

30 minutes after the last start, but not later than the sunset, part IV (sailing rules) of the I. Y. R. U. will cease to be applicable and will be replaced by the international Regulations for the Prevention of Collisions at Sea.

In the event of an infringement of the sailing rules the Racing Committee is entitled to move a participant down one place in the record if the fault is insignificant and if disqualification or time added in accordance with the RORC regulations is considered by the Racing Committee to be too severe a penalty.

When the use of an engine is allowed during a race, the propeller shaft is to be securely locked.

All yachts must show starboard, port and stern navigational lights from one hour after sunset to one hour before sunrise. Breach of this rule will be prosecuted by the Racing Committee. As navigational lights may be obscured by headsails a powerful torch must be kept handy to illuminate the sails when necessary.

Yachts abandoning the race should report as soon as possible to the Racing Committee, cable address: ASS - ÅBO. Telephone: 35 83 08.

Race abandoned must be indicated by hoisting national colours.

The Racing Committee reserves the right to make alterations in the programme.

#### PROTESTS

Written protests accompanied by the stipulated Protest fee (Sw. kr 100:-) are to be handed in at the Regatta Office at Åbo. Written or telegraphed protests must be lodged within two hours after the protesting yacht has arrived at anchorage, even if it has not completed the race. All protests must be made in conformity with the International Yacht Racing Rules.

The decisions of the Racing Committee are final and without appeal.

## REPORT FROM MASTER OF YACHT
