

NOTICE OF THE RACE

FINN EUROPEAN CHAMPIONSHIP'S 6-14 JUNE 1992 GDANSK SHIPYARD YACHT CLUB



1. VENUE

The Finn European Championships '92 will be hosted by the Gdansk Shipyard Yacht Club, under the auspices of the Polish Yachting Association and of the Town Council of Gdansk.

2. RULES

The races will be governed by the International Yacht Racing Rules of the Y.R.U. 1989-1992 edition the prescriptions of the Polish Yachting Association, the Rules of the Finn Class and the Sailing Instructions

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRIES

All competitors must be paid up members of National Finn Association, recognised by the I.F.A.

The limits resulting from membership fees are valid, acc. to I.F.A. rules.

Deadline for entries is April 30th 1992.

USD -150 -if forms sent after the deadline

5. EVENT CLASSIFICATION AND ADVERTISING

In accordance with Appendix 14 of the IYRU the event is classified category B.

6. SCORING SYSTEM

The Olympic Scoring System, Appendix 5.1 of the IYRU will apply except that 4 races shall be completed to constitute the series of the Championship.

If 5 or more races are sailed, the result of the worst race will be excluded

7. MEASUREMENT CERTIFICATE

All Competitors must hold a valid measurement certificate.

8. ALTERNATIVE PENALTIES

The 720 Turns, Appendix 3.1 of the IYRU, will apply

9. RIGHT OF APPEAL

Decisions of the International Jury will be final in accordance with IYRR 1.5

10. RESPONSIBILITY

Each competing yacht must be insured against third party risks for the whole period of the races as well as during the races.

The organizing Club and the various committees appointed by the Club will bear no responsibility whatsoever for any accident or damage personal of material suffered during the races or at any other time during the period of the races. Competitors participate entirely at their own risk and responsibility.

11. REPORTING IN

To the Secretariat of the Championship, situated in the Club house, where Measuring and Sailing Instructions will be given to competitors, together with other complementary data and a list of the social events.

12. LOCATION

The Gdansk Shipyard Yacht Club is situated approximately 10 kilometers east of Cit Gdansk centre.

13. TROPHIES

Prizes will be awarded to the winner of each race. Overall prizes will be presented to first 20% of entered yachts, according to final results.
